Matang to stay in CBI custody

KOLKATA, 7 FEB: An Alipore court today sent former Union minister Matang Singh to CBI custody till 11 February in connection with the Saradha chit fund scam. After successfully arguing in the court that Singh's custody should be extended as he is an important lead in the Saradha scam case, the central agency obtained a stay from a district sessions judge of Alipore Court against a lower court verdict that had granted him judicial custody till 13 February.

ACJM (in-charge) of Alipore Court, Manikuntala Roy, granted the CBI the remand of Singh for five days' though the agency had sought seven days' custody. The defence counsel cited the ill health of the former Union minister while praying for his bail. The lawyers contended that Singh is a grade II liver transplant patient and needed special medical attention and sending him to police custody might put his life in danger. The prosecution argued that the accused was part of a larger conspiracy and a beneficiary of the Saradha Group of companies.

The former Union minister also mentioned in the court that

the investigating officer in this case visited his home and hospital in Delhi and was sympathetic to his medical condition.

The minister told the reporter that the question should be asked of those who supply liquor to him. When prodded further, he turned abusive and told the reporter to pose the question to the reporter's family members or his employer who Mitra implied, had filled the reporter with

Five member CID team probing Arup murder case

KOLKATA, 7 FEB: A five-member CID team probing the murder of 26-year-old Arup Bhandari at Howrah's Salkia today met his family members and recorded their statements.

Arup, a resident of Rishikesh Ghosh Lane, was brutally assaulted by the miscreants while he was returning from an immersion ceremony on 28 January. He slipped into a coma and died at a private clinic in the city on 2 February. His family members claimed that he was beaten up after he protested eve teasing by the miscreants, while the chief minister who had met the family

of the victim last Wednesday had linked the incident with factional feud. Police have arrested one person in this connection while four are still at large.

The team members met the family members of the slain youth and talked at length with them about the incident. The grieving family members retreated that they would not rest until they get justice.

Later, the investigators also took Abhijit Basu, Arup's friend and an eyewitness to the assault, to the spot where Arup was beaten up and tried to know the sequence of events as to what exactly transpired that fateful day.



V-C confined by Visva-Bharati students

SANTINIKETAN, 7 FEB: Students confined the Vice-Chancellor of Visva-Bharati in his house at Santiniketan for more than 24 hours demanding discussion with the authorities on their demands. When the authorities asked the students to talk over the admission issue, they refused. They decided to continue their sit-in demonstration tonight.

Yesterday students confined the V-C in his house. After a long time the V-C returned to Santiniketan and attended the inaugural programme of Magh Mela. After that the students sat for a sit-in demonstration in front of the Vice-Chancellor's house. They sat there throughout last night.

Yesterday they demanded discussion with the Vice-Chancellor on their demands. This afternoon the pro-vice chancellor Swapan Kumar Dutta called the students over phone for discussion. But the students refused. Today students demanded talks over every issue raised by the agitators. However, the authorities wished to talk only about the admission issue. "We are fighting against all irregularities in the university during the tenure of the present vice chancellor Sushanta Dutta-gupta. It's not only the students who are taking part in the stir. The teachers, professors and workers are also fighting. The authorities have to talk to all the representatives," said Jamsed Ali Khan, a student representative.

BJP member thrashed by TMC men

GOGHAT, 7 FEB: A BJP worker while going to his in-laws' house was kidnapped by a gang of 12 TMC men and thrashed brutally. He was rushed to the Arambagh Hospital by his family members. Nirmelendu Choudhury said that the locals rescued him from the TMC men who threatened him of dire consequences. But Pradip Roy, a local TMC leader, said that none of the TMC men were involved in the incident. A police complaint was lodged against Choudhury who had earlier thrashed some TMC men. **sns**

'WBMC shielding negligent doctors'

KOLKATA, 7 FEB: The West Bengal Medical Council (WBMC) is yet to cancel the registrations of five doctors in the state whose names have already been removed from the Indian Medical Registrar (IMR) by the Medical Council of India on charges of negligence, alleged Dr Kunal Saha, president of People for Better Treatment.

Dr Saha, speaking to media at Kolkata Press Club through a tele-conference today, alleged that WBMC is trying to save the doctors even after the Medical Council of India has directed it to take necessary steps against the doctors who had committed

negligence during treatment leading to the deaths of some patients.

"WBMC is run by the doctors associated with Trinamul Congress with Dr Nirmal Maji as its president and is trying to shield these accused doctors and is reluctant to cancel their registration as the accused belong to this political party. As a result these doctors continue medical practice in various parts of the state," Dr Saha alleged.

He also said these doctors will continue practice until the WBMC cancels their registration.

Removal of names from IMR was not enough to keep them away from treating patients in

various health establishments.

Dr Biman Saha Roy, whose wife Soma Saha Roy had become a victim of medical negligence during operation at Uma Medical Institute on VIP Road alleged that WBMC did not take any steps against the doctors ~ Dr KK Das, Dr Joydeep Basu and Dr Tapan Mukherjee ~ whose negligence could have killed his wife at this private hospital.

People for Better Treatment under Dr Kunal Saha helped him to approach the MCI, which after conducting an inquiry removed the names of Dr KK Das, Dr Joydeep Basu and Dr Tapan Mukherjee from the IMR for five, two and three years respectively.

City school raises bar for hygiene

CHAKDAHA, 7 FEB: A school with a difference and a loud and clear message of sanitation and hygiene, Kamalpur Adarsha Vidyaipith for Girls, stands tall in a neighbourhood where most of the people come from low-income group families, education is still a luxury and sanitation not important whatsoever. Kamalpur Adarsha Vidyaipith for Girls (KAVG), winner of an UNICEF award ~ Nirmal Vidyalaya Purashkar 2013 ~ has set a very high standard of cleanliness and hygiene not only for the neighbourhood but for other

schools as well. The school is one of the success stories of "Swacha Bharat Mission" launched by the government on 2 October 2014 and spearheaded by Dr. P B Salim, District Magistrate, Nadia in the district who has also taken up the cause of 'Open Defecation Free' Nadia. KAVG, a government-aided school, was established in 1971 with a commendable teacher-student ratio of 40:1. Most of the students hail from low-income group families. Ms Krishna Bhadra, headmistress of KAVG, said, "Almost 90 per cent of our students are from economically and socially backward classes.

Majority of our students are first generation learners." The sparkling cleanliness and hygiene of the school is maintained by its students and teachers alike. There are separate bins for bio-degradable and non bio-degradable products. Bio-degradable products are emptied into one of two pits, each used for six months, where it is composed to form bio-fertilizer. The fertilizer is then used in the garden. "We never throw anything on the floor. We see anything on the floor, we immediately dispose of it in the suitable bin. We always tell younger students to follow health and hygiene habits

as taught by our teachers and urge them to practice at home as well," said Bidisha Ghosh, a student of class X. KAVG has other ambitious projects in their kitty as well ~ rain water harvesting, generation of solar power. The school is constructing a 10 feet deep reservoir to hold rain water; the water thus collected would be pumped to water the garden and supply water to a fountain which would soon be constructed. Ms Bhadra said: "We want to start with small things like running the inverter, cooking meals using solar power."
