Dear Dr. Menabde:

Originally a physician from India, I've been permanently settled in USA for the past more than two decades. I'm also the founding-president of "People for Better Treatment" (PBT), a charitable organization dedicated to improve healthcare delivery system and prevent medical corruption in India. I'm writing this letter to seek your kind cooperation in regard to an issue of great significance to Indian as well as international medical community and public at large.

We have been having a serious dispute with World Medical Association (WMA) since they recently reinstated a corrupt medical man and ex-Medical Council of India (MCI) president, Dr. Ketan Desai, as WMA president-elect for 2016. As you may know, while working as MCI president, Dr. Desai was caught red-handed by the highest Indian law-enforcing agency (CBI) for taking bribe from a private medical college in 2010. Under our relentless pressure, Dr. Desai's medical license was suspended indefinitely by MCI and he was also removed from the post of WMA president-elect in 2010. The sordid saga of Dr. Desai was also reported in top International medical journals including British Medical Journal (BMJ) and Lancet which brought great ignominy to all doctors of Indian origin (copy attached).
